11.1 P280-DMSE/100514/F-Holmes Grove, Upton Bishop HR9 7UQ-Additional Information. The Parish Council made the following comments: The landscaping does not change the Parish Council's objection to this application.

11.2 P282A&B-DMSE/100613/FH & L-Construction of two dormer windows to the front elevation & one to the rear & construction of new sunroom. Two Parks Farm, Linton, HR9 7UH. Permission refused on 28/06/10. The Clerk was asked to obtain clarification as to the situation regarding the dormer windows as only the sunroom was mentioned in the refusal notice.

11.3 P283-DMSE101105/FH-2 storey extension, new porch below existing first floor structure, Windy Bottom, Gorsley. HR9 7SF. Permission granted on 05/07/10.

11.4 P286-DMS/100832/O-To build two four bedroom houses and hard-standing for garage. Brick Lane, Linton Road, Sugar Tump. Gorsley HR9 7FF. Council has no objections.

11.5 P287-DMS/101476/F-Alterations and conversion of existing building to form dwelling with ancillary works. Land adjoining Oakland, Blindman's Gate, Gorsley HR9 7SE. The Parish Council notes the change to the site entrance. This is now onto the main road, opposite the school, by the pedestrian crossing and with a bus stop at the end of the path. The previous entrance was safer. The Clerk will ask if a hazard/visibility survey has been carried out.
