7.1 <b>Talk by Keith Eyles-Enforcement Officer, Herefordshire Council</b> The Enforcement Officer investigates incidents of fly-tipping to check if there is any evidence that can be used to prosecute the person responsible. Keith Eyles said that there is an ever increasing problem with fly-tipping and that all incidents should be reported to either CHDC or the Police. Recently criminals have been calling on people asking if they would like garden waste/household items disposing of, they then charge the person to get rid of the items and then dump them. He pointed out that if you pay someone to dispose of items for you; you are still legally responsible if they then dump the items, even if you paid them. It is the owner's responsibility to ensure that their items are disposed of properly.
